



Attendance Policies

Building and practicing routines is an essential component of establishing an optimal learning environment for children and young adolescents. We understand that life happens and sometimes it is just not possible to arrive at school on time, but we urge you to be prompt as often as you can to enhance your child's experience and growth. The first moments of each day are important in helping students be welcomed, settle in, and have an overview of what is to come during the day.

If your student will be absent, late to school, or need to leave school early for any reason, please notify us by emailing attendance@pinecobble.org or calling the Main Office at 413.458.4680

We kindly ask that you use email whenever possible. When notifying us, please include:

- **Student's full name and grade**
- **Date, time, and type of absence (full day, late arrival, or early dismissal)**
- **Reason for the absence (if due to illness, briefly describe symptoms)**

All students arriving after 8:00 am, or leaving school prior to 3:00 pm MUST BE SIGNED IN/OUT of the main office by their caregiver, or someone previously authorized to pick up your child from school.



Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures:

Student Safety is our priority, and we need your help to keep the drop-off and pick-up times safe for students. Please familiarize yourself with the procedures outlined in the handbook and be mindful to follow these protocols.

DROP-OFF

- **The roadway that goes to the Lower School was intended as one way – while it has been modified to accommodate two-way traffic - it remains narrow. Please drive with extreme caution.**
- **Drop off for early morning ASK for all grades is in the Dining Room in Cluett.**
- **Drop off for students in Beginners through Third grade is in the Lower School parking lot.**
- **Students in grades Four through Eight can be dropped off in the main parking lot.**

PICK-UP

- **Students in Beginners through Kindergarten are picked up in the Lower School lot.**
- **Students in grades First through Eighth are picked up in the main parking lot.**
- **Guardians are asked to exercise caution and patience and follow the directions of staff.**
- **If you have multiple students at Pine Cobble, please pick up all your students at your youngest's pickup location. Older siblings will be sent to the Lower School lot for pickup if they have siblings in Early Childhood.**

Please do not park or pick-up on the roadways. It both hinders the flow of traffic and is potentially unsafe. There are four short-term visitor parking spaces by the main entrance to Cluett House. These spaces are for visiting families and those who will be using them for a short period of time.

The front circle is to be used only for LATE drop-offs and EARLY pickups. Please do not park in the front circle, even for a short period of time. The fire chief has expressed that there should not be any cars parked in the circle.

Anyone needing to park and come into the school for other purposes should use the main parking lot, or if available, the visitor spots.
